Guidelines for International Student Application for Admission to Loras College

- Complete the Application for Admission. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE.**
- **No application fee is required.**
- Have **official/original transcripts (no photocopies)** from secondary school work sent. **Transcripts must be translated in English with all course grades listed.** (An explanation of the grading system should accompany academic records)
*Transfer students must submit not only work from secondary school but **also official transcripts from each college attended.***
- **All applicants who are not native speakers of English must submit results from an ENGLISH proficiency examination.** TOEFL (school code 6370), PBT (paper based score) 550 or better, CBT (computer based score) 213 or better, IBT (internet based score) 79 or better. IELTS 6.5 or better. STEP Eiken Grade1 (advanced), Grade Pre1 (high intermediate). Cambridge First Certificate.
- A limited number of students will be accepted to Loras College for the 2007 fall semester. Acceptances will be selective and based on academic achievement, English proficiency exam score, letters of recommendation, personal statement, and extracurricular activities.
- **Submit all original (no photocopies) financial documents, including Declaration and Certification of Finances/Affidavit of Support and a recent notarized bank statement (dated within the past 30 days) verifying amount of funds available.**

All information must be completed in order to be considered for acceptance to Loras College. **I-20's will not be issued until applicants are accepted.**

Applicants should apply as a first-year student if completed junior year or graduated from high school and have less than 12 hours of college credit.

Applicant should apply as a transfer student if they have completed 12 or more hours of college credit.

Loras College admits students regardless of race, age, gender, religion, ethnic origin, or physical disability.
